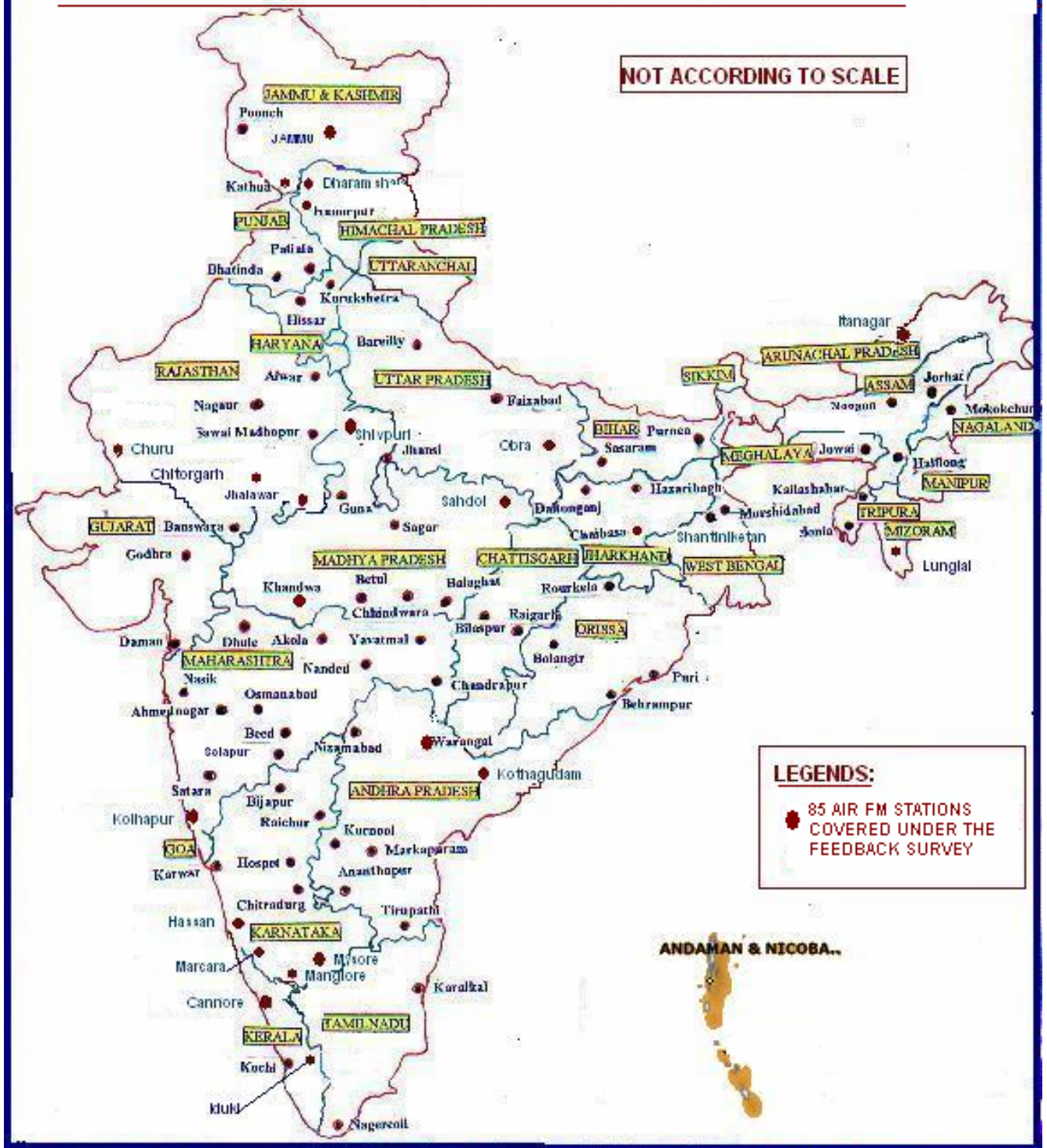

## **STUDY PROFILE**

- **Name of the Study** Feedback Survey on Kisanvani Programme under the scheme ‘Mass Media Support to Agriculture Extension’
- **Research Design.** Audience Research Unit, DG,AIR.
- **Period of field survey** 10<sup>th</sup> February - 9<sup>th</sup> March, 2006  
(9<sup>th</sup> to 12<sup>th</sup> Week of study)
- **Place of survey** 675 Villages in primary coverage zone of 85 AIR, FM Stations spread over 24 States and two Union Territories across the country.
- **Sample Size** 6739 Pre-informed farmers @ 2 villages per week per FM Station and 10 farmers per village
- **Research Tool** Pre-coded Structured Questionnaire.
- **Data Collection** By Part-time casual Investigators trained for this purpose & supervised by the Audience Research Units of respective states/assigned units.
- **Data Compilation, Analysis & Report writing.** Computerized at Headquarters, Audience Research Unit, DG, AIR, New Delhi.
- **Preparation of Report** June, 2006

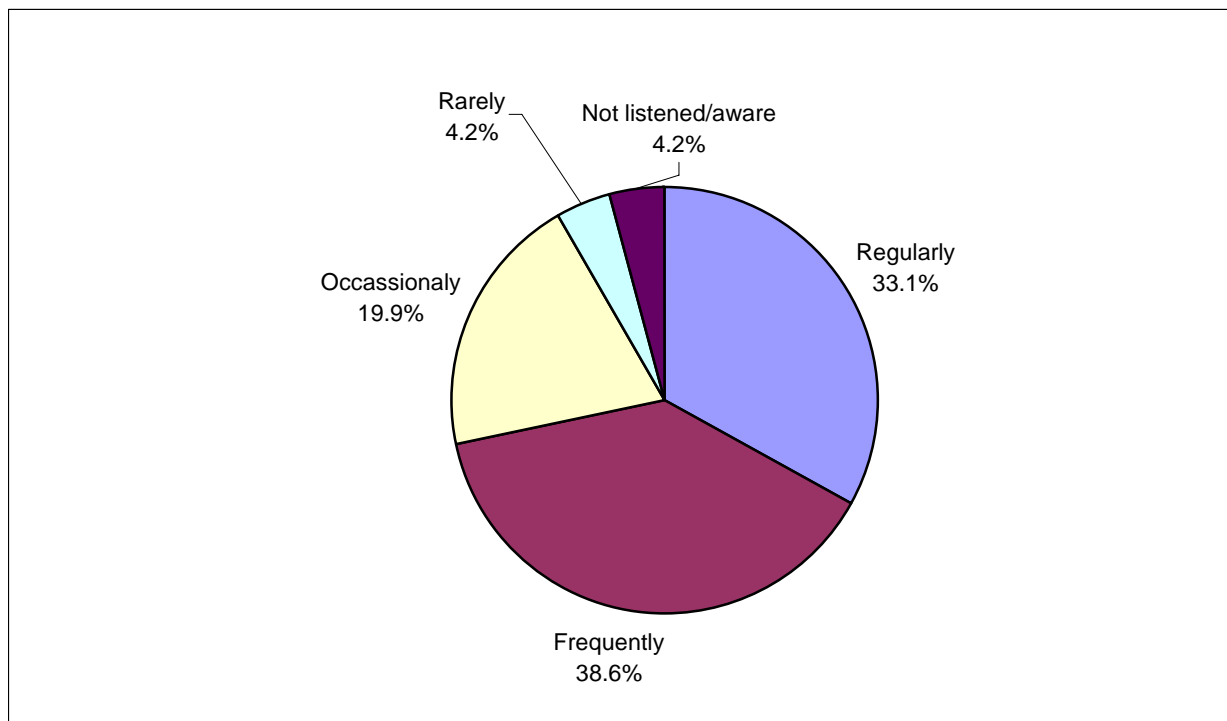
## MAP SHOWING AIR FM STATIONS COVERED UNDER KISANVANI FEEDBACK SURVEY



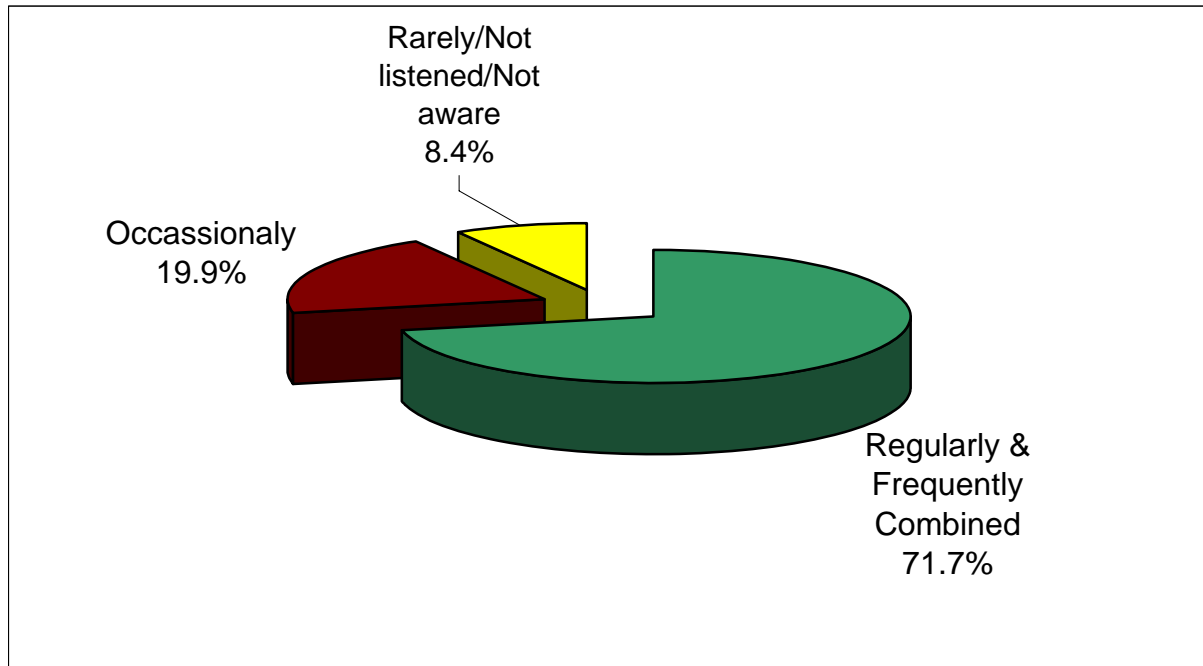
## **SALIENT FINDINGS**

- Since the target audiences of the Kisanvani programme are farmers, the occupation of majority of the respondents selected for the interview (90.2%) was farming. Of which, percentage of small farmers was maximum (30.6%) and close to it was marginal farmers (30.1%).
- The survey found 33.1% of the sample respondents as regular listeners (5-7 days a week) of the Kisanvani programme and 38.6% as frequent listeners (3-4 days a week). Percentage of frequent & regular listeners putting together comes to 71.7%. There was a slight increase (1.3%) in the percentage of regular & frequent listeners combined over the previous fortnight (26<sup>th</sup> January –9<sup>th</sup> February,2006)

### **Frequency of listening to Kisanvani**

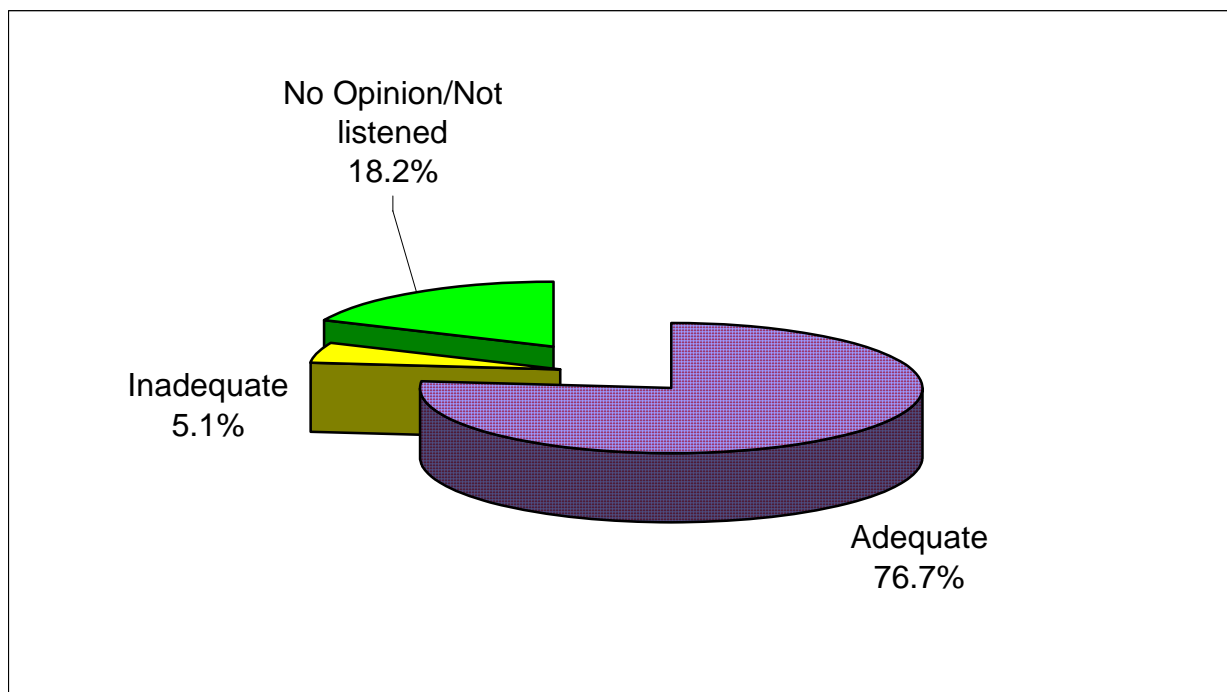


### Listening: Regularly & Frequently combined



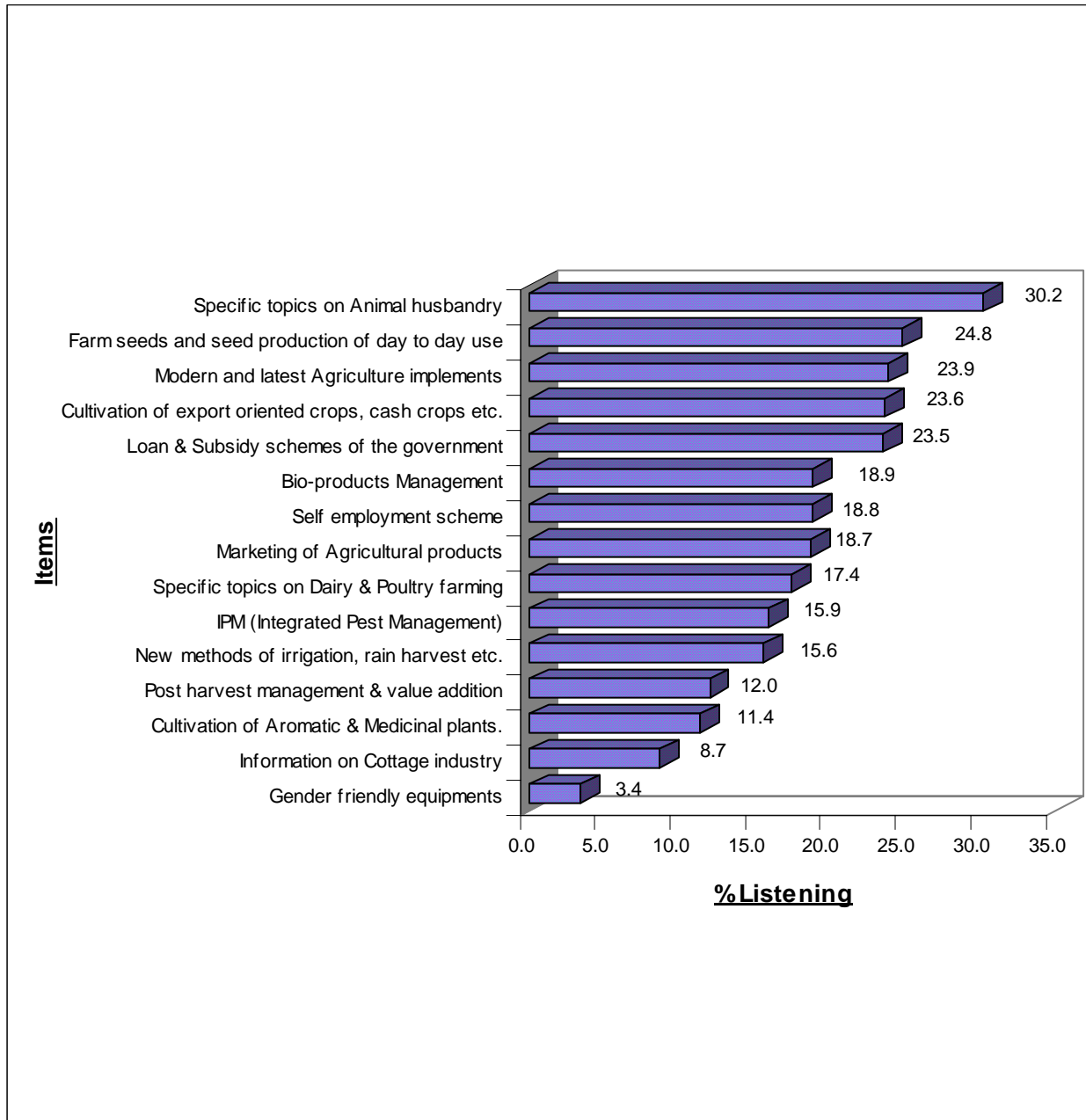
- Majority of the respondents (76.7%) found the contents of the Kisanvani programme to be adequate whereas 18.2% did not give any opinion/didn't listen to programme.

### Adequacy of the programme contents



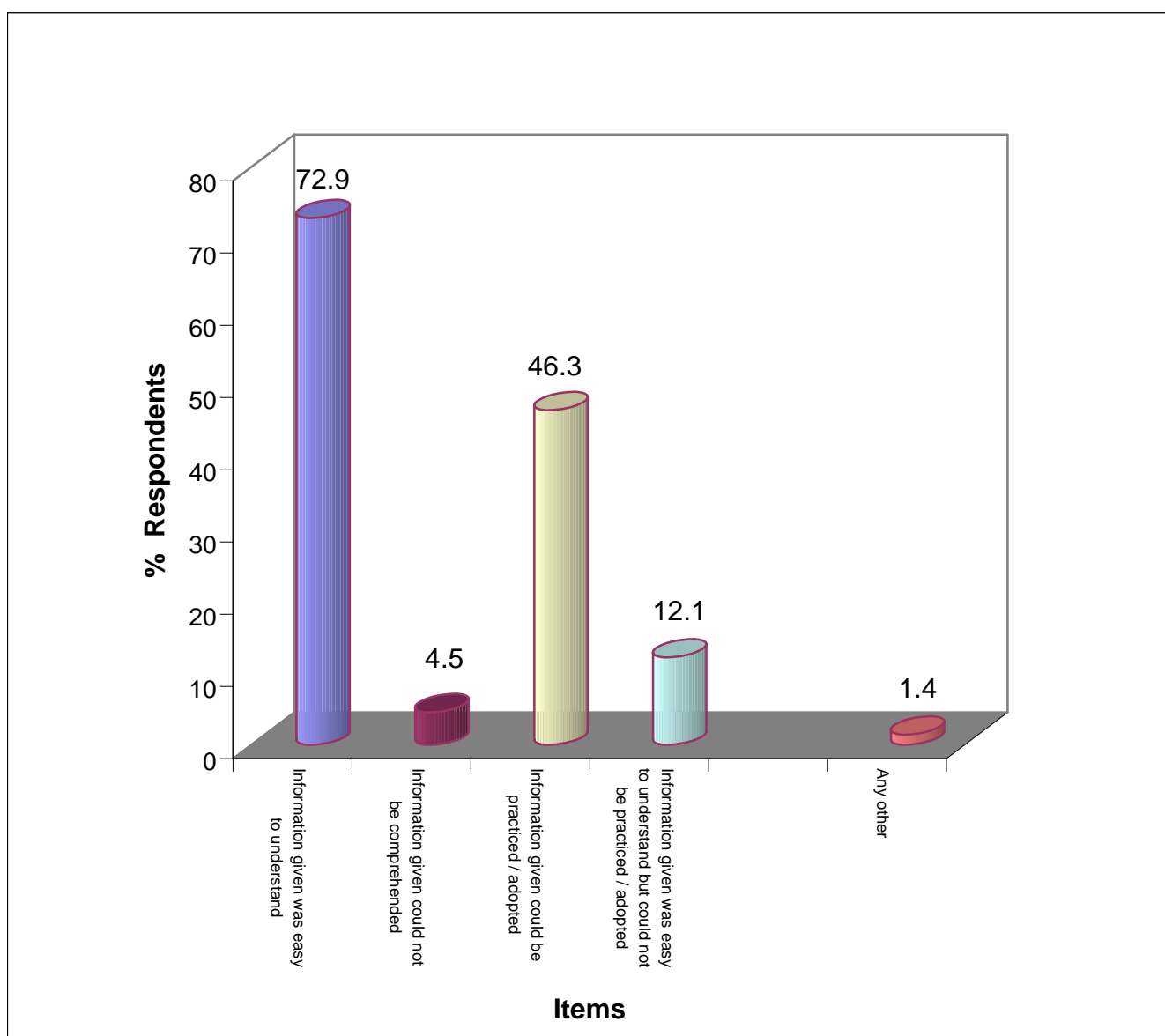
- Items listened under the Kisanvani programme in order of ranking (highest listening to lowest) are depicted below: -

- When asked to give the opinion on the information given under the Kisanvani programme, maximum number of respondents (72.9%) reported that the information given was easy to understand. Of which, 46.3% could practice/adopt the information given under the Kisanvani programme and 12.1% found the information given under the Kisanvani programme easy to understand but could not practice/adopt. Whereas a little less than 5% could not comprehend the given information.

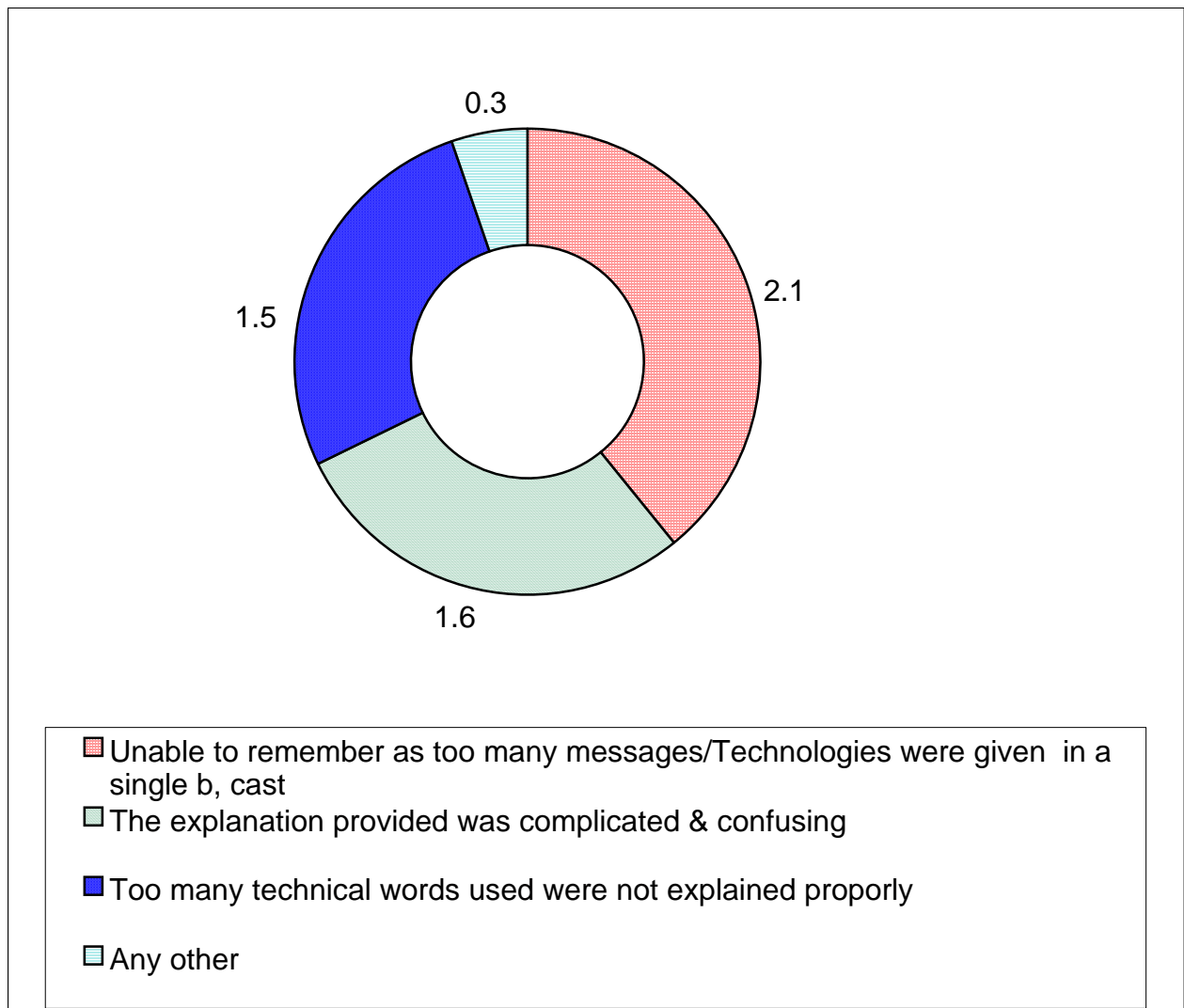
### Opinion on Kisanvani Programme



□ Further probe into the reasons for not understanding the information given in the programme revealed that highest number of respondents (2.1%) were ‘unable to remember the information as too many messages/technologies were given in a single b’cast’ followed by ‘the explanation provided was complicated & confusing’ (1.6%). Another reason for not understanding the information given under Kisanvani was that too many technical words used in the b’cast, were not explained properly (1.5%).

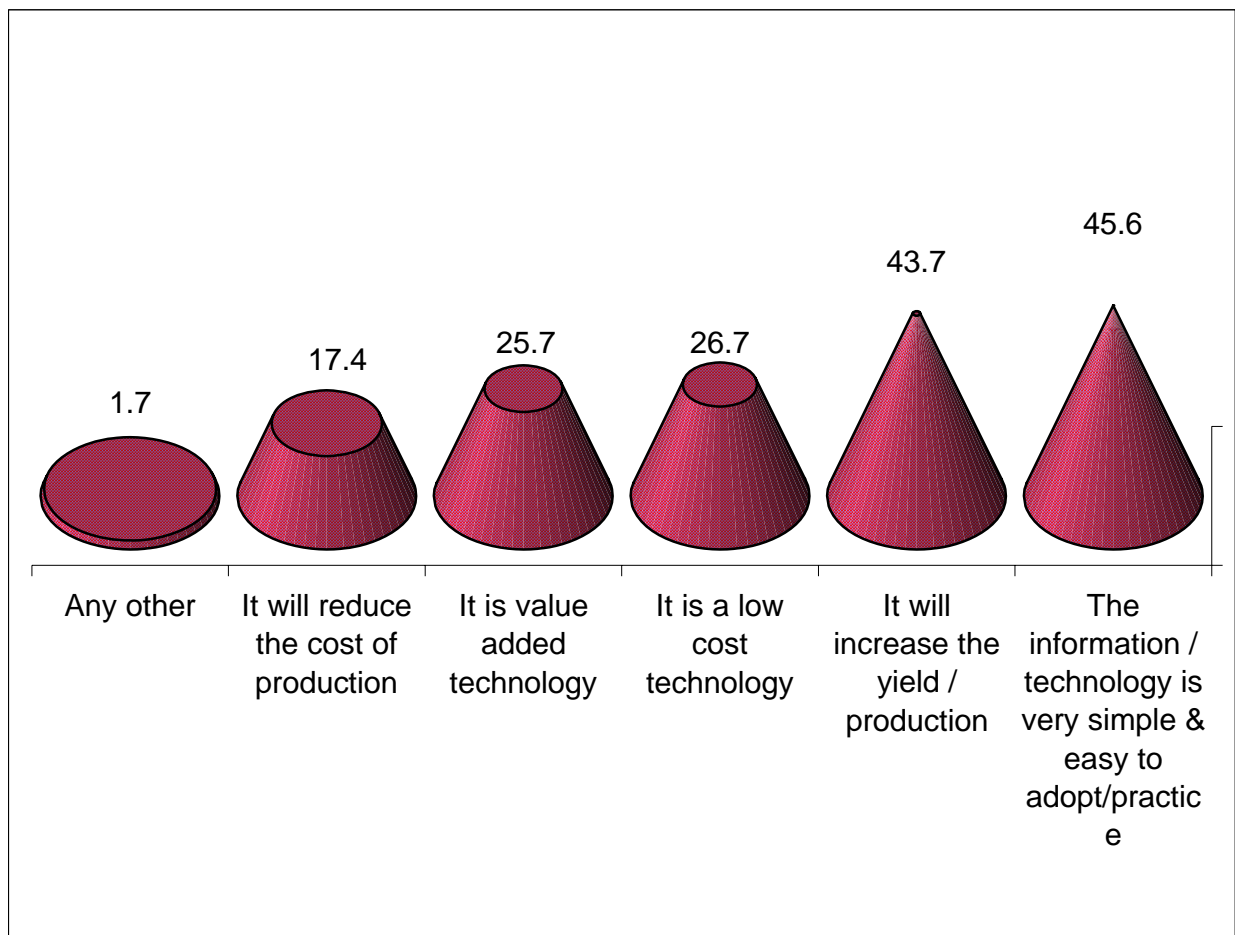
**Reasons for not understanding the information given in Kisanvani**

**Programme**



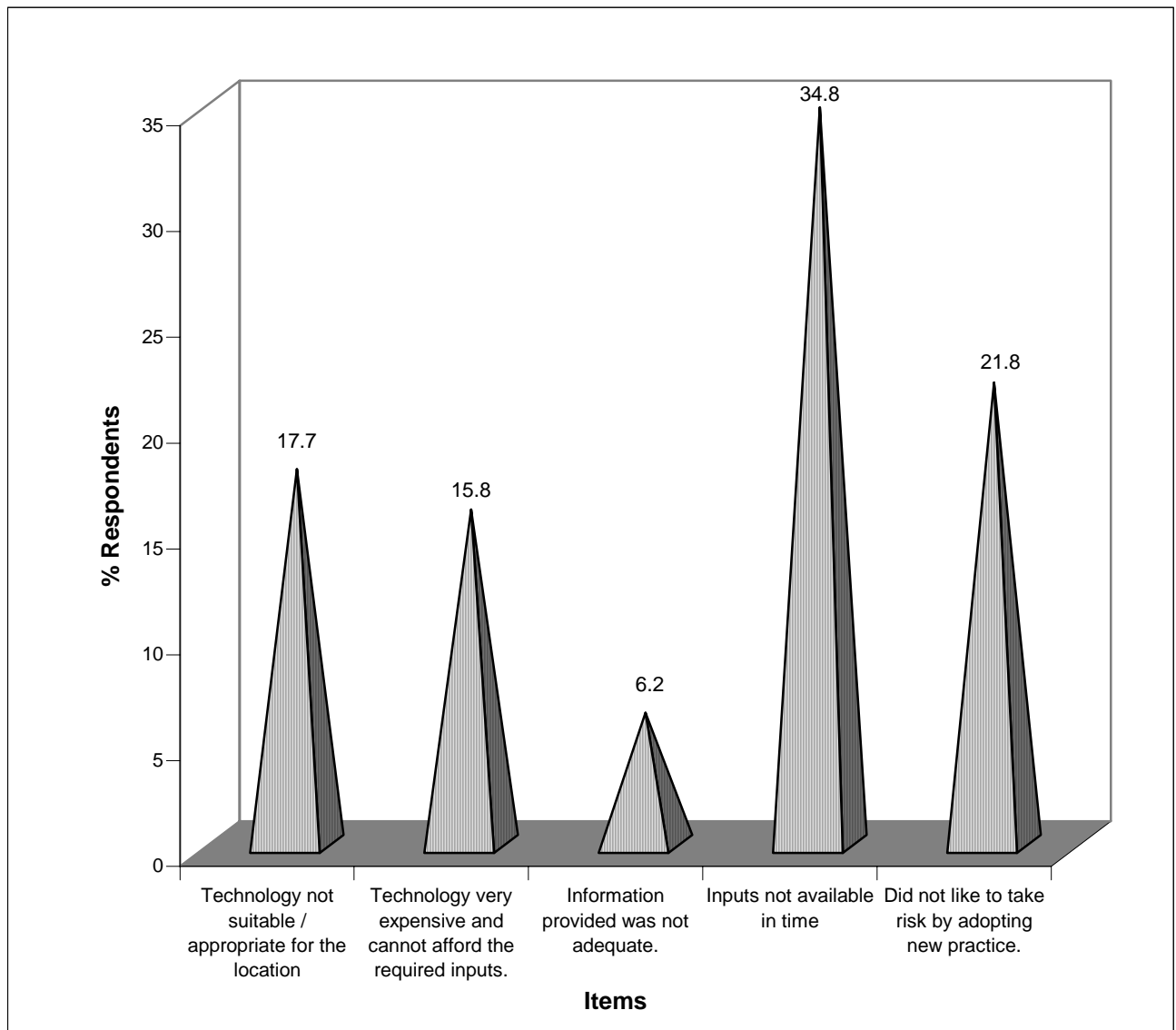
□ While eliciting the reasons for adopting the technology/information provided under the Kisanvani programme, it was observed that maximum number of respondents (45.6%) had the opinion that the technology/information was very simple and easy to adopt/practice. This was followed by the reason that ‘it would increase the yield/production’ (43.7%) and ‘it was low cost technology’ (26.7%).

**Reasons for adopting the technology**



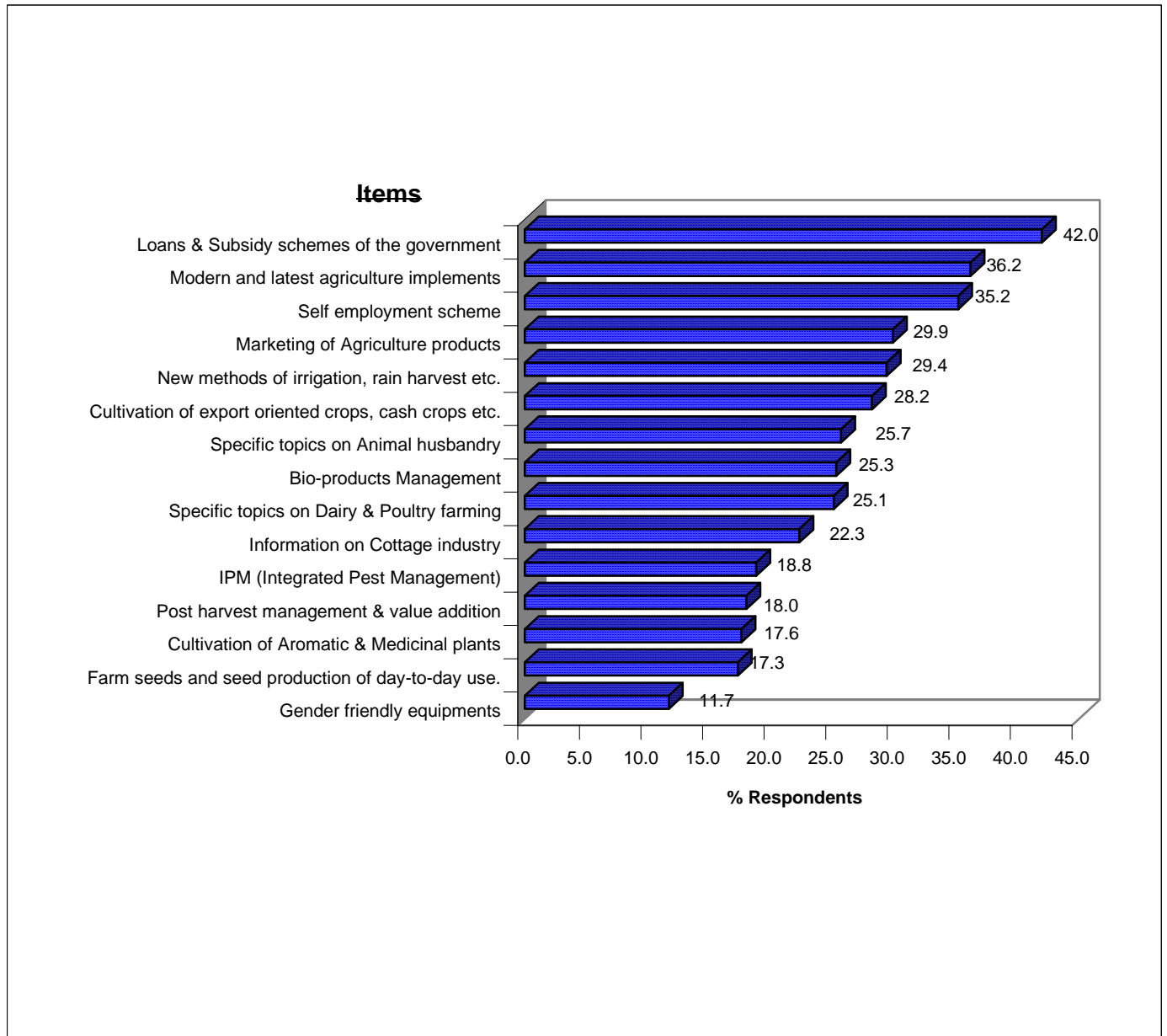
□ As regards major bottlenecks faced by the farmers in adoption of technology/information provided under the Kisanvani, majority of the farmers (34.8%) reported that inputs were not available to them timely whereas 21.8% did not like to take risk by adopting new practice. 17.7% felt that technology was not suitable/appropriate for the location and 15.8% were the view that the technology was very expensive and could not afford the required inputs.
